

November 30th Strike Action Oxfordshire Rally

Over 3 million workers are due to strike on 30th November against plans to force us to work longer and pay more for, but get less from, our pensions. NASUWT supports the Oxfordshire campaign to make a united show of shared anger by taking part in a joint march with workers from all Education settings, which will then further combine with workers in health and other parts of public service for a combined Rally in Oxford City Centre.

Education Workers

All striking Education workers should gather in Harberton Mead, Marston, Oxford between 1 o'clock and 1.30 for a 1.30 start to the march.

Gather near our Federation Banner; bring whistles and rattles and any placards you can make. There will be NASUWT Marshals to show you where to go.

This march is for all Teachers, Head Teachers and TAs from Maintained Schools and Academies, Teachers in Independent Schools whose pensions are with the TPS, supply Teachers, and balloted Further education colleagues. Bring supporters. Talk to everyone in your school beforehand to get as big a turnout as we can muster, NASUWT members and workers in other unions: Teachers, Head Teachers, TAs, Office and support staff. March together as a School contingent.

March Route

The march will go along St Clements to the Plain, where we will join with Health workers and other Council Workers and Civil servants who will have started from the London Road and the Cowley Road.

The joint march will then go up the High and be joined by disabled strikers and supporters at Carfax.

Then along Cornmarket for a **Joint Rally on Broad street at 3.30.**
